OBJECTIVES OF CCC

The Career Counselling & Competency Cell (CCC) has been established to support students in academic planning, career guidance, placements and professional development. The cell helps students identify career opportunities, prepare for interviews, build professional resumes and improve communication skills. CCC also organizes workshops, industry interactions, internships, career fairs and skill enhancement programmes. Through continuous mentoring and counselling, the cell aims to improve student confidence, employability and long-term career growth.

Code of Professional Conduct

Healthcare professionals must maintain the highest standards of discipline, ethics and responsibility. Students are expected to respect patients, faculty members, clinical supervisors, technical staff and peers at all times. Professional communication, punctuality, personal hygiene and proper grooming are essential in clinical and academic environments. Any misconduct, discrimination, harassment or unethical behaviour shall be treated seriously. Students must remember that professionalism reflects both personal character and institutional reputation.

Clinical Posting Guidelines

Clinical training is one of the most important components of healthcare education. Students must report to hospitals and clinical areas in complete prescribed uniform along with identity cards and logbooks. Patient confidentiality, ethical conduct and respectful behaviour must always be maintained during postings. Students should strictly follow instructions given by clinical supervisors and hospital authorities. Mobile phone usage, photography and inappropriate conversations in patient-care areas should be avoided completely.

Laboratory Safety & Infection Control

Laboratories are highly sensitive learning spaces where safety and discipline are mandatory. Students must wear gloves, masks, lab coats and other protective equipment whenever required. Biomedical waste disposal protocols and infection control measures must be followed carefully to prevent contamination and accidents. Equipment should be handled responsibly and any malfunction or accident should be reported immediately. Students must avoid negligence, casual behaviour and unsafe handling of chemicals or biological specimens.

Attendance & Academic Responsibilities

Regular attendance and academic participation are essential for professional growth and competency development. Students are expected to attend theory classes, practical sessions, demonstrations, seminars and clinical postings regularly. Timely submission of assignments, records, case studies and project work is compulsory. Academic honesty must be maintained during examinations, assessments and practical evaluations. Continuous absence, indiscipline or malpractice may lead to academic penalties as per institutional norms.

Placement & Internship Support

The Placement & Internship Cell supports students through career counselling, interview preparation and industry networking. Internship opportunities are coordinated with hospitals, diagnostic centres, NGOs, rehabilitation centres and healthcare industries. Students receive guidance regarding resume preparation, communication skills and professional presentation. Placement drives, career talks and employer interactions are organized regularly to improve employment opportunities. Students are encouraged to maintain professionalism during internships as they often become gateways to future employment.

Resume & Portfolio Development

Every healthcare student should maintain a professional resume and competency portfolio. The resume should clearly mention educational qualifications, technical skills, certifications, internships, workshops, research activities and extracurricular achievements. Students are also encouraged to maintain digital portfolios including presentations, projects, publications and case studies. A strong portfolio reflects clinical exposure, communication abilities and professional growth. CCC shall conduct workshops to guide students regarding modern healthcare resume formats and LinkedIn profiles.

Research, Innovation & Publications

Research and innovation play an important role in improving healthcare systems and patient outcomes. Students are encouraged to participate in research projects, poster presentations, conferences and scientific discussions. Activities such as data collection, case study preparation and healthcare surveys help students develop analytical and critical thinking abilities. Originality, ethical practices and evidence-based learning must always be maintained during research activities. Students interested in innovation and entrepreneurship shall also receive guidance through institutional mentorship programmes.

Soft Skills & Personality Development

Healthcare professionals interact with patients, doctors, nurses, families and multidisciplinary teams every day. Therefore, communication skills, empathy, confidence and professionalism are equally important as technical knowledge. CCC organizes workshops on personality development, leadership, emotional intelligence, stress management and interview preparation. Students are encouraged to improve spoken English, presentation abilities and interpersonal communication. These skills help students become confident professionals capable of handling real healthcare environments effectively.

Entrepreneurship Opportunities

The healthcare sector offers significant opportunities for entrepreneurship and independent practice. Students can establish diagnostic laboratories, imaging centres, optical stores, rehabilitation clinics, wellness centres and healthcare consultancy services. Emerging healthcare technologies and digital healthcare systems are also creating new startup opportunities for skilled professionals. CCC shall guide interested students regarding healthcare business models, legal permissions, branding and professional networking. Entrepreneurship allows healthcare professionals to create employment opportunities while contributing towards community healthcare services.

International Career Opportunities

Healthcare professionals are in demand globally due to expanding healthcare systems and ageing populations in many countries. Students interested in overseas opportunities should explore international licensing examinations, English proficiency tests and country-specific registration requirements. Many countries offer employment opportunities in radiology, laboratory sciences, rehabilitation, emergency care and public health sectors. CCC shall provide basic guidance regarding international admissions, scholarships, migration pathways and skill recognition processes. Students must also understand ethical responsibilities while working in multicultural healthcare environments.

Student Support Services

IPH&H is committed towards creating a safe, inclusive and student-friendly academic environment. The institution provides mentorship, academic guidance, grievance redressal and counselling support whenever required. Anti-ragging measures, gender sensitivity awareness and student welfare initiatives are implemented to maintain a respectful campus culture. 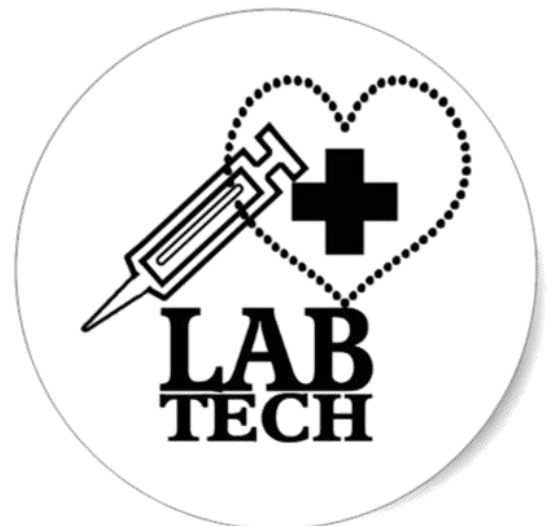
RADIOLOGY & IMAGING TECHNOLOGY

Students are trained in diagnostic imaging procedures such as X-Ray, CT Scan, MRI, Ultrasound and advanced imaging technologies. The course focuses on patient positioning, radiation safety and image quality management. Graduates may work in hospitals, diagnostic centres and imaging departments. Opportunities also exist in equipment application support and international healthcare sectors. The field continues to expand with technological advancements in digital radiology and AI-assisted diagnostics.



MEDICAL LABORATORY TECHNOLOGY

This programme develops competencies in clinical laboratory diagnostics including pathology, microbiology, biochemistry and hematology. Students learn sample handling, laboratory safety, reporting systems and diagnostic procedures. Graduates can work in hospitals, pathology laboratories, blood banks and research facilities. The demand for laboratory professionals continues to rise due to growing diagnostic healthcare services. Entrepreneurship opportunities also exist through independent laboratory setups.



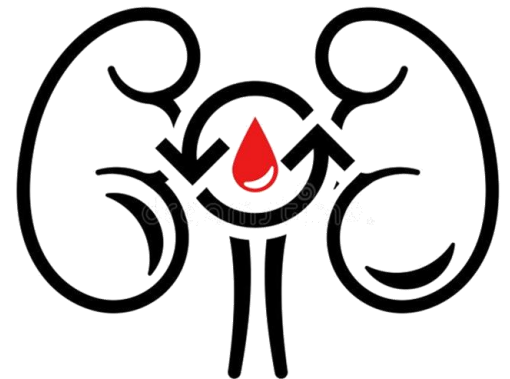
OPERATION THEATRE TECHNOLOGY

Operation Theatre Technology prepares students to assist surgical teams during operative procedures. Students are trained in sterilization techniques, surgical instrumentation, anaesthesia support and operation theatre management. Graduates may work in multispeciality hospitals, trauma centres and surgical units. Professional discipline and emergency handling skills are essential in this field. The course offers strong employment opportunities in both public and private healthcare sectors.



DIALYSIS TECHNOLOGY

Dialysis Technology focuses on renal care and management of patients suffering from kidney disorders. Students are trained in haemodialysis procedures, dialysis machine operation and patient monitoring. Graduates can work in nephrology departments, dialysis centres and critical care units. The increasing prevalence of kidney diseases has created significant demand for trained dialysis professionals. Compassionate patient care and technical competency are extremely important in this domain.



OPTOMETRY & VISION CARE

This programme trains students in vision testing, eye care practices and optical dispensing. Students develop competencies in refraction, contact lens handling and primary eye care screening. Graduates may work in eye hospitals, optical centres and ophthalmology clinics. Students can also establish independent optical and vision care centres. With increasing awareness regarding eye health, optometry has emerged as a highly promising healthcare profession.



PHYSIOTHERAPY & REHABILITATION

Physiotherapy focuses on physical rehabilitation, pain management and movement restoration. Students learn therapeutic exercises, electrotherapy techniques and rehabilitation planning for various medical conditions. Graduates may work in hospitals, sports centres, rehabilitation clinics and wellness centres. The profession plays an important role in improving quality of life and functional independence. There is also increasing demand for physiotherapists in sports medicine and geriatric care.



EMERGENCY & TRAUMA CARE

Emergency and Trauma Care trains students to respond effectively during medical emergencies and accident situations. Students learn first aid, trauma response, patient stabilization and emergency medical support. Graduates can work in emergency departments, ambulances, disaster response units and trauma centres. The field requires quick decision-making, emotional stability and teamwork. Growing emergency healthcare infrastructure has increased career opportunities in this sector.



PUBLIC HEALTH & COMMUNITY HEALTHCARE

Public Health programmes focus on disease prevention, health awareness and community-based healthcare systems. Students learn epidemiology, healthcare administration, sanitation and health education strategies. Graduates may work with NGOs, government health departments and international health organizations. Public health professionals contribute significantly towards national healthcare planning and disease control programmes. The field has gained tremendous importance after global public health challenges and pandemics



FORENSIC SCIENCE & MEDICO-LEGAL STUDIES

Forensic science combines scientific investigation with legal and criminal justice systems. Students learn forensic biology, toxicology, crime scene investigation and medico-legal procedures. Graduates may work in forensic laboratories, law enforcement agencies and medico-legal departments. The field requires analytical thinking, scientific precision and ethical responsibility. Technological advancements continue to create new opportunities in forensic analytics and cyber forensics.



NUTRITION & DIETETICS

Nutrition and Dietetics focuses on therapeutic nutrition, health counselling and dietary planning. Students learn nutritional assessment, meal planning and clinical nutrition management for different diseases. Graduates may work in hospitals, wellness centres, sports nutrition facilities and community health programmes. Awareness regarding preventive healthcare and lifestyle diseases has increased demand for nutrition professionals. Entrepreneurship opportunities also exist in wellness consultancy and diet planning services.





HOW CCC HELPS STUDENTS FOR CAREERS IN INDIA & ABROAD ?

The Career Counselling & Competency Cell (CCC) acts as a bridge between students, healthcare industries, hospitals, higher education institutions and career opportunities. The cell regularly conducts career guidance sessions, placement preparation workshops, industry interactions and higher education counselling programmes. Students receive guidance regarding career pathways in India as well as international healthcare opportunities in countries facing healthcare workforce shortages.

For Indian career opportunities, CCC supports students regarding internships, placements, government sector opportunities, competitive examinations and entrepreneurship pathways. Students are guided regarding preparation for interviews, resume development and communication skills required in healthcare institutions. Career alerts, recruitment information and professional networking opportunities are also shared regularly.

For overseas opportunities, CCC guides students regarding higher education admissions, eligibility requirements, international licensing pathways, English proficiency examinations and global healthcare demand sectors. Students are also supported regarding application documentation, statement of purpose writing, recommendation requests and professional profile development. The objective is to help students become globally competent healthcare professionals with confidence and clarity regarding future career growth.



ISSUANCE OF LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION (LOR) & BONAFIDE CERTIFICATES

Students applying for higher education, scholarships, internships or overseas academic programmes may require Letters of Recommendation (LORs) from the institution. LORs are issued based on academic performance, attendance, professional conduct, clinical competency and overall student participation. Students are expected to submit formal requests within the prescribed timelines along with supporting documents such as resume, academic details and application information.

For overseas higher education applications, recommendation letters help universities understand the student's academic strengths, professional ethics, communication abilities and clinical exposure. LORs shall be treated as confidential professional documents and will normally be issued directly through institutional procedures

Bona-fide certificates may be issued to students for employment opportunities, internships, government documentation, educational purposes and verification requirements in India. Students must apply formally through the concerned department or administrative office. The institution reserves the right to verify eligibility and authenticity before issuing official documents.

IMPORTANCE OF RESUME BUILDING

A resume is one of the most important professional documents for every healthcare student and graduate. It represents academic qualifications, technical competencies, clinical exposure, achievements, certifications and professional strengths. A strong resume creates a positive first impression during interviews, internships, placements and higher education applications.

Healthcare employers and universities often evaluate resumes to understand the practical exposure, communication abilities, leadership qualities and professional attitude of applicants. Therefore, students should regularly update their resumes with workshops, projects, research activities, certifications and extracurricular achievements.

Students are encouraged to maintain both printed and digital resumes along with professional online profiles such as LinkedIn. CCC shall conduct resume development sessions to help students understand modern healthcare resume formats and professional

RESUME WRITING TIPS

- Keep the resume clear, professional and concise.
- Mention accurate contact information and professional email address.
- Highlight healthcare skills, clinical exposure and technical competencies.
- Include internships, workshops, certifications and practical training.
- Mention leadership roles, volunteer activities and research work.
- Avoid unnecessary decorative formatting and grammatical mistakes.
- Use action-oriented words and achievement-based descriptions.
- Update the resume regularly with new experiences and achievements.
- Keep the resume truthful, professional and easy to read.
- Tailor the resume according to the specific job or academic application.

IMPORTANCE OF PERSONAL GROOMING

Personal grooming is an essential part of professionalism in healthcare education and clinical practice. Patients, hospital staff and employers often form their first impression based on appearance, communication style and personal hygiene. Well-groomed healthcare professionals reflect discipline, responsibility, confidence and respect towards patients and the profession.

Healthcare environments require professionals to maintain cleanliness, hygiene and proper presentation because they directly interact with patients and healthcare teams. Good grooming also improves self-confidence, communication abilities and workplace behaviour. Students must understand that professional appearance contributes significantly towards employability and institutional reputation.

CCC shall organize personality development and grooming workshops to help students develop professional etiquette suitable for hospitals, healthcare institutions and corporate environments.

PERSONAL GROOMING TIPS FOR HEALTHCARE STUDENTS

- Maintain personal hygiene and cleanliness at all times.
- Wear neat, ironed and appropriate professional attire.
- Keep nails clean and avoid excessive accessories or strong perfumes.
- Maintain proper hairstyle and professional appearance.
- Wear clean clinical uniforms and identity cards during postings.
- Practice polite communication and confident body language.
- Develop good posture, eye contact and listening skills.
- Maintain professional behaviour on social media platforms.
- Avoid casual language in professional settings.
- Focus on punctuality, discipline and respectful interaction with patients and staff.
