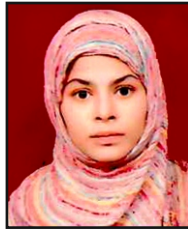

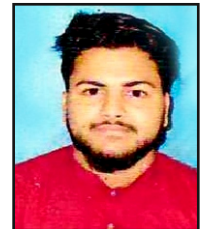

SIMULATION-BASED CLINICAL LEARNING ENVIRONMENT

IPH&H promotes experiential and skill-based healthcare education through simulation-assisted clinical learning designed to prepare students for real healthcare situations with greater confidence and competence. The Institute encourages hands-on learning through guided practice, structured demonstrations, and scenario-based training that strengthens clinical understanding, decision-making, teamwork, and patient-care skills in a safe and supervised environment.

CAMPUS : The self-sufficient campus features excellent infrastructure and resources, fostering a vibrant educational environment for male and female students, including internationals. It emphasizes a strong foundation in the humanities and sciences, with new departments like Medical Laboratory and Imaging Sciences, Dental Sciences, and Communication Technology.

HOSPITAL WARD SIMULATION : The Institute runs a 24-hour charitable hospital and specialized polyclinic in New Delhi, providing services such as X-ray, pathology, physiotherapy, dental, and eye care. This facility trains Diploma and Degree candidates and includes an HIV-AIDS Testing and Counselling Center, Immunization Clinic, Laboratory, Radiology, and Ultrasonography services, collaborating with government hospitals and diagnostic centers to enhance its offerings.

LABORATORIES : The Institute boasts well-equipped medical laboratories featuring modern equipment. To facilitate practical training for candidates, it is also affiliated with various diagnostic centers, as well as well-equipped government hospitals and nursing homes.

DEPTT. OF RADIOLOGY : The Department is furnished with a sufficient number of X-Ray units, including those with Fluoroscopy capabilities, mobile X-Ray units, and Dental X-Ray units.

DEPTT. OF ECG : The Department is equipped with adequate no. of 3 Channel fully automated BPL, WIPRO ECG Machines.

DEPTT. OF ULTRASONOGRAPHY : The Ultrasonography Department of the Institute is outfitted with state-of-the-art ultrasound machines for training purposes and utilization in the hospital's mobile clinic.

COMPUTER TRAINING : Our state-of-the-art computer laboratories provide students with access to the latest research and technological advancements in medical studies. The high-speed internet-enabled workstations facilitate effective and efficient study practices for our students.

DEPTT. OF OPHTHALMOLOGY : The facility is outfitted with the most advanced equipment, including an Ophthalmic Surgical Operating Microscope, Keratometer, Sinoptophore, Streak Retinoscope, and Direct Ophthalmoscope, to provide comprehensive ophthalmic treatment.

DEPTT. OF DENTAL SCIENCES & DENTAL LABORATORY : The facility provides dental treatments to patients using the latest computerized and state-of-the-art equipment, offering dental services that allow young students to gain valuable clinical experience.

DEPTT. OF PHYSIOTHERAPY : The facility is outfitted with advanced computerized and manual physical therapy and rehabilitation equipment, providing a comprehensive range of services for disabled patients while also offering students valuable clinical experience.

DEPTT. OF PHARMACOLOGY : The facility is outfitted with state-of-the-art instruments and equipment utilized in the production of pharmaceuticals.

NURSING FOUNDATION LAB. : The facility is thoroughly equipped with a sufficient number of models, educational charts, advanced nursing manikins, CPR dummies, and sophisticated maternal and neonatal emergency simulators, all specifically tailored for professional nursing education.

NUTRITION LAB. : The space is adequately ventilated, furnished, and outfitted with all the essential amenities of a Nutrition Lab, including cooking and serving utensils, glassware, a refrigerator, a dining table with chairs, a gas stove, raw ingredients, and a weighing scale, among others.



COMMUNITY HEALTH NURSING LAB. : The Community Health Nursing Lab is designed to provide students with the necessary resources, including a sufficient number of community bags filled with essential items for community health nurses. This setup enables students to learn the home visiting bag technique and to carry out various procedures during home visits.

PRE CLINICAL SCIENCE LAB. : The facility is thoroughly equipped with a variety of models and specimens, including bones, skeletons, and relevant charts. Students are encouraged to utilize our Anatomy lab to study the anatomy of bones, joints, and other systems. The lab features advanced compound microscopes, histological slides, models, 3D charts, specimens, and manikins.

MATERNAL & CHILD HEALTH (MCH) LAB. : The facility includes maternity and gynecological examination models, a delivery model, charts, and equipment. The Child Health Lab features models, charts, and play therapy materials, enabling students to develop essential nursing skills for caring for newborns, infants, and children. It is equipped with pediatric mannequins, a crash cart trolley, emergency medications, and equipment for routine and emergency child health care.

ADVANCE NURSING LAB. : The objective of this laboratory is to deliver comprehensive practical knowledge in advanced nursing procedures, facilitated by subject matter experts. Additionally, we offer a BLS practice segment focused on teaching high-quality CPR techniques.

DEPTT. OF BIO-TECHNOLOGY : The facility is outfitted with PCR and other advanced computerized instruments and equipment. Students also gain practical experience by being assigned to various esteemed and well-established Research Biotechnology Departments within government and semi-government organizations.

DEPTT. OF DISTANCE & CONTINUING EDUCATION : The Department consists of over forty programs that provide access to a wide range of educational resources. These post-professional courses encompass diverse methods for clinical interventions and advancements in technology. The primary focus of the Department is on service professionals within the Allied Health sector who have work commitments.
